IT'S EASY! Start NOW; follow these steps.

- 1. <u>Apply NOW</u> online at cabrillo.edu Admissions. Submit the Cabrillo College Application for Admission for FALL 2017 as *new first time college student*:
 - Allow 2-3 days for processing.
 - Your Cabrillo College student ID# will be emailed to you.
- 2. To qualify for Running Start, you must complete these steps in this order by the dates listed:

Now-April 14, 2017: complete the Cabrillo Online Orientation at sirena.cabrillo.edu .
Now-April 14, 2017: take the assessment test for placement in math and English: check with your
counselor for dates and times. See requirements to attend an Assessment session below.
By March 2: Apply for Financial Aid for priority funding: Cabrillo.edu/services/finaid .
By April 7, 2017: submit CAASPP/EAP and AP scores and transcripts to Admissions & Records for
prerequisite clearance in math, English and chemistry.
By April 14, 2017 : Attend an Education Plan Workshop or Student Planning Session to plan your classes online using <i>Student Planning</i> , check with your counselor for workshop dates and times.

To qualify for Running Start - complete the above steps by April 14, 2017

- ☐ **April-May 2017:** Before registration you can:

 - 2. Re-assess if needed, see Assessment Calendar: Cabrillo.edu/services/assessment
- MAY 19, 2017: Register for FALL 2017. If you completed ALL of the above steps by April 14, you can register for classes online using WebAdvisor/Student Planning: wave.cabrillo.edu

□ **Plan and Register for CG51:** *Planning for Success.* You'll complete this class in summer or fall 2017. This is a REQUIRED class to maintain your continued priority registration for spring 2018.

For all Assessment sessions: Arrive 30 minutes prior to the start time for check-in and seating, late entry is not allowed. **Be prepared** with these three requirements, exceptions cannot be made:
