At least 45% of students will participate in a sport. 3. 90% or more of students will report they feel connected to Harbor as measured by the California Healthy Kids Survey (CHKS) and/or Emotional Health Survey (SEHS) and/or WASC surveys. 4. At least 50% of teachers will use positive behavior referrals (Pirate Pride -- Student Recognition). 5. Total attendance will increase at least .5%. 6. Total out-of-school suspensions will decrease by at least 10%. 7. Students will show Pirate Pride with Harbor wear. 	<p>Objectives</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Re-evaluate and share updated safety procedures, such as evacuation drills/routes and “Code Red” drills and adjust due to construction and recent national events. 2. Add security cameras campus-wide and speed bumps in upper and lower parking lots. 3. 100% of teachers show powerpoint during lockdown drill of safety procedures and school rules. 4. All visitors and guest teachers follow check in procedures and wear visible visitors’ badges. 5. 90% or more of students will report they feel physically and emotionally safe at Harbor as measured by the California Healthy Kids Survey (CHKS) and/or Emotional Health Survey (SEHS) and/or WASC surveys.
