Harbor High School is a comprehensive high school with approximately 940 students enrolled in grades 9-12. There are 65 faculty members, 3 counselors and 3 administrators. Harbor High School has a diverse student body and provides its students with varied educational programs ranging from comprehensive college preparatory to exceptional vocational curriculum among many other programs on our campus. Harbor High School is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, was awarded Gold Ribbon School in 2015 and is a California Distinguished School.

Curriculum

Harbor High School utilizes an A/B/C Block Schedule. Students attend 3 classes each day A and B Day for a total of 105 minutes each. On C Day students attend all 6 classes for a total of 50 minutes each. Students are also given the opportunity to take a 00 period as a 7th class. This is allowed under certain circumstances such as being deficient in credits or wanting to participate in a specialized program while still taking 6 academic classes. There are two semesters composed of three six-week grading periods.

Weighted calculation of academic courses completed in grades 10 – 12, in which one extra point is given for each honors and advanced placement course with a grade C or better.

Based on the student's Weighted Academic GPA.

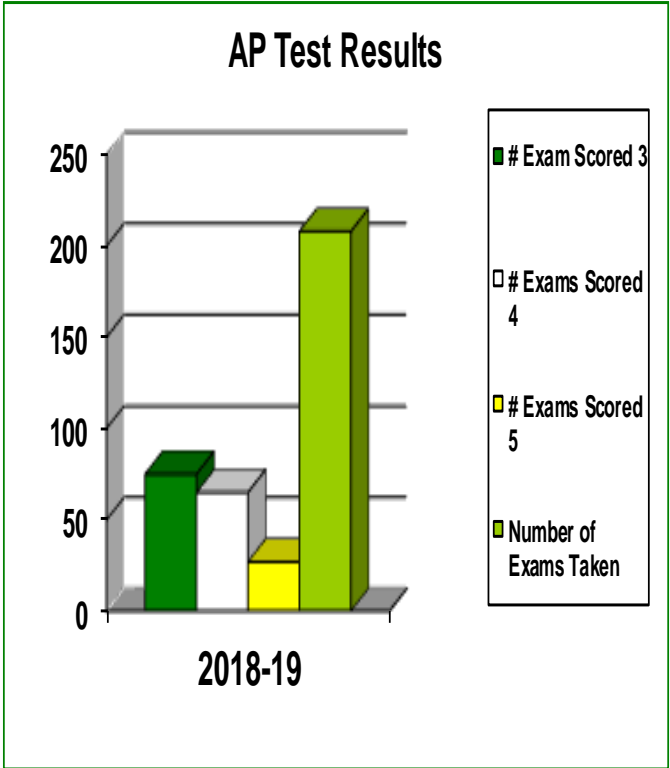
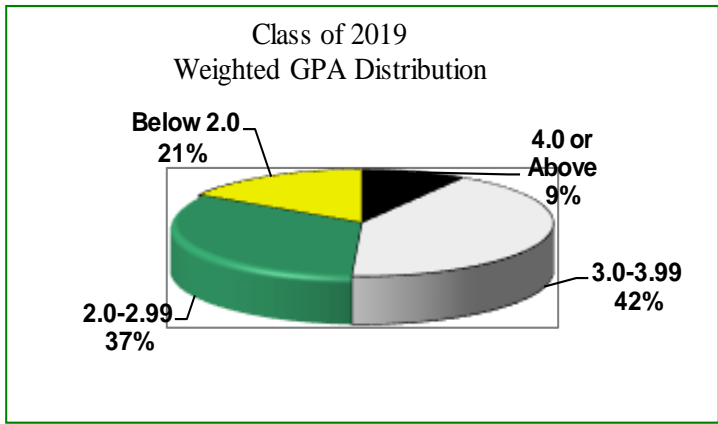
